

Notice Regarding Acquisition of Shares (Consolidation)

1. Reason for share acquisition

TENOX CORPORATION (the “Company”) and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as the “Group”), a corporate group dedicated mainly to supporting the peace of mind and safety of society through the construction of foundations for civil engineering and architectural structures, announced today that it has made Ohmishima Bussan Corporation (outlined below) a subsidiary.
